Hazards

HEALTH:

Irritates skin, eyes and respiratory tract. Prolonged contact may promote dermatitis. Ingestion may cause nausea, stomach cramps, diarrhea, ulcerations, liver and kidney damage.

Fire/Reactivity

Non-Combustible. High moisture conditions will cause hydrolysis to sulfuric acid. May react violently on contact with strong bases.

Directions For Use

Wearing appropriate personal protective equipment, throw small amounts of the granular PhosControl evenly across the surface of the pond. In ponds smaller than .05 acres, test the pH while applying small amounts of PhosControl to ensure the pH doesn't drop below 6. If the pH approaches 6, do not apply more PhosControl until the pH level increases. Do not apply PhosControl directly to the floating algae mats or an unsightly white floc may persist.

Emergency Measures

FIRST AID:

Skin: Wash with water.

Remove any contaminated clothing

Eyes: Rinse immediately and thoroughly with water. Hold eyelid open. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Inhalation: Move to fresh air. If symptoms persist, get medical attention.

Ingestion: Give plenty of water or milk. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Get medical attention.

Protective Measures

Keep material dry. Use local exhaust ventilation at source of emission. Wear safety glasses, impervious gloves, and dust mask if necessary.
